**Taskforce Member Job Description**

Members of the Taskforce will develop and implement a community organizing and advocacy program aimed at changing community norms and physical environments that place vulnerable Latinos in Ventura County at high risk for contracting HIV.

**Specific Responsibilities:**

- Attend quarterly Taskforce Meetings.
- Serve on a committee (optional).
- Map the current social and physical environments in Ventura County that put Latino at high risk for HIV.
- Identify and prioritize cultural, social and environmental factors to be targeted.
- Develop and implement at least two plans to change social and cultural norms.
- Identify evaluation strategies.

**Time Commitment:**

- One to three year position
- Quarterly Taskforce meetings, 1½ hours in length
- Committee meetings as needed (optional)

**Personal Qualities:**

- Commitment to reducing the risk of HIV infection among Latinos in Ventura County
- Knowledge of Ventura County and the Latino Community
- Interest and skill in collaborative efforts
- Resourcefulness
- Ability to view the "Big Picture" and engage in long range planning
